Letter from the Baby Rescue Centre Social Worker

My full names are SALOME KERUBO MAOYA. I came from a tribe called kisii.

Am a born again Christian and I love being in the presence of God always, Though my Dad and mom are not strong in Christianity I always pray for them. I got saved when I got married and it was my husband who inspired me with the word of God and later he took me to church where I received Jesus Christ and got saved.

I got married in 1998 customarily and God has blessed me with two children a boy and a girl. The boy was born in 1999 September and the girl in 2002 February. We are happily married .

Since I got married I had to transfer my city from Eldoret to Kitale to be together with the man I love. I have come to find Kitale being a good town to me because people there are busy working and doing Agriculture, we have a lot of business going around Kitale since it is the only town that serves people from Somali, Sudani and Ethiopia.

When I got saved I had a passion to serve God in a different way, then I started doing charity work by praying and visiting people who are less fortune, counseling people who have lost value in life. After doing these is when my pastor encouraged me to go for a course that is how I landed myself as a social worker. To me I love being with people whom I can add value to their life I worked with challenge farm where we have street kids and they have a story to tell how they hate themselves and how they leaved a street life that was very harsh to them. In the period I was with them they came to love and respect God knowing that he was their savior.

When my contract with them expired I left and participated in woman organisation to teach women on family planning and home management. It is during this period when I met with Naomi and she became a nice person to me. She asked me to visit the Baby rescue and when I did for the first time I felt joy in my heart because the work she was doing was very wonderful, She really inspired me and this time I asked her if I could be of help to her and she gave in. I came to love the kids and all the people around especially those that are funding the project. My prayer is to see Baby rescue grow into a big thing.

I have taken the responsibility of taking them to church and my prayer is to make them forget their past and focus to the future by knowing that God is their only father who will not forsake them.

For now am trying all my best to see that the centre be registered the officer's of the children registration have not come to inspect the centre and we are waiting for them. They are the final people who will decide. So continue praying with us, us we continue with the process.
